Over the Counter Medications	
Nyquil	Sudafed
Tylenol	Cough medicine containing dextromethorphan (DM)
Advil PM	Stimulant drug of choice: avoid pseudoephedrine
Benadryl	Depressant drug of choice: avoid diphenhydramine

Other Products	
Vanilla extract	Mouthwash containing alcohol
Cooking wine	Rum cake
Perfumes	Liquor flavored cakes and candy
Colognes	Energy drinks (Red Bull, Monster, 5 Hour Energy)
Rubbing alcohol	Kombucha teas
