Treatment Plan

Livengrin drug and alcohol treatment programs combine education on mind and body development during recovery; group, individual, and family therapy; and a family education component. A patient's length of stay and type of Outpatient Service is based on the individual's clinical needs.

Mission Statement

Making sustainable recovery possible through professional, accessible, and successful treatment options.

Vision Statement

Provide a process of change for those suffering from addiction whereby a life of recovery is achieved, emotional and physical health is stabilized, and family networks are improved.

Outpatient Programs

- **Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP):** Consists of group treatment (including recovery skill building, group counseling, addiction education, recovery education) three times per week, nine hours per day, and individual and family sessions as clinically needed
- **General Outpatient Program (GOP):** Consists of one group treatment session, one time per week, three hours per day
- One-on-one individual sessions
- Family sessions

There are day and evening sessions available. Schedule depends on the individual Counseling Center.
